Review: Combining sentences

- Too many short sentences in a paragraph will make it sound choppy and keep the ideas expressed in the paragraph from flowing properly.
- Too many clauses combined using coordinating conjunctions, such as and, but, and so, can
 make your paragraph repetitious. Over-coordinating might also result in the grouping of too
 many unrelated ideas.
- To fix these problems, use a variety of sentence combining techniques. For examples of these techniques, click on the HINT button in this exercise.
