Correcting words often confused (*there* vs. *their*)

- There are words that are confused because they sound similar:
 - Example: *There/their*
*At the community meeting last week, **there** were several individuals who complained that **their** concerns were not being given enough attention.*

- There are words that are confused because they are spelled in a similar manner:
 - Example: *Except/expect*
*Most tenants, **except** those who live in rent stabilized units, **expect** their rents to continue to rise considerably.*
