Using the base form after modals (could, must) and do

- Use the base forms of verbs after *do*, *does*, and *did*.
 - o Example: Marisol didn't come to school yesterday.
- Use the base forms of verbs after modals such as must, should, can, and might.
 - o Example: Pedro should study hard this semester.
- Use the past participle forms of verbs if the modals are followed by HAVE or BE.
 - Example: *The application forms* **must be filled** out in ink.
 - o Example: I think they **should have told** us about the change of schedules.
